Superintendent Jeff Eakins and School Board members join community leaders and design and construction professionals in a ceremonial “first dig,” to break ground on our new high school, the first high school built in the District in more than ten years. This school is being built after collecting three years of impact fees from the county and is not a referendum project.

**Building with Design and Function:** District is committed to building with design and function that will provide opportunity and equitable learning environments that serve the needs of all of our students while working in partnership with our programming stakeholders. The goal is to build a learning environment that not only simulates students life in the modern world but for any postsecondary track they pursue in the 21st Century.

**School Attendance Boundaries:** The site is located on the north side of County Road 672 (Balm Road), east of US Highway 301. Students assigned to specific areas within the East Bay, Lennard, Newsome, and Durant High School attendance boundaries are proposed to be reassigned to the new High School, with the exception of students who are currently in 10th grade. Students who are currently in the 10th grade will be allowed to stay at their existing schools. Proposed boundary changes for “TTT” High School will be effective August 2020. No proposal is final until School Board approved. School Board readings are scheduled for two upcoming board meetings: December 4, 2018 and January 15, 2019.
